

The Gokseong Seomjingang Observatory is along the beautiful and clean Seomjingang Riverside. The observatory provides the perfect environment for observing the universe, with the main observation room having a 600mm astronomical telescope produced by the Korea Astronomy and Space Science Institute, a second observation room with a highly precise telescope, a planetarium with an 8m circular dome screen and a learning hall displaying a variety of astronomical data.

Amnok Imagination School has emerged as a new play and culture space with the Seomjingang Train Village.



Dongaksan Mountain, the true mountain in Gokseong, has two peaks, a northern and southern peak around Baeneomeojae Pass. The northern peak is Dongaksan Mountain, and the southern peak is Hyeongjebong Peak. The main hiking trails are formed around Hyeongjebong Peak. When entering Dorimsa Temple and walking about 200m long, you will realize why Dongaksan Mountain is called the 'most distinguished bedrock in the southern region'.




Seomjingang Riverside Hiking



Then, he taught disciples here.

Yongsanjae Shrine was built on the birthplace of General Shin Sung-gyeom, the meritorious retainer founding of a dynasty.
